Abandonment of Lake Placid Dam

DNR has not provided a written response to the application for abandonment, however, preliminary concerns have been made by DNR staff regarding the planned grouting of the culvert under McClaine Rd. Other options may be required. A determination of stream history by DNR staff is also pending.
