



New Boater Safety Law In Effect

Self-proclaimed “Grey-haired Grandpa in the far North,” and long-standing SRA member John Bartosz reminds us that the governor signed a new boater safety law in May of '06 that goes into effect this season. All persons born after Jan 1, 1989 must take and pass a boater safety course to legally operate any sort of motor boat on Wisconsin waters—and must carry the certificate while under way. John encourages parents and grandparents to attend classes and sharpen up their own skills. Most boater safety courses offered in other states will suffice and online courses are also offered.
