SUBJECT: BOATING ENFORCEMENT ACTION ON YOUR LAKE

Dear Waterfront Owner:

I am writing to inform you of the boat registration regulations in Wisconsin. If you already have your boat registered in Wisconsin, then you are already aware of the Wisconsin rules and this letter does not apply to you. If you have a boat which is registered in another State and you use it in Wisconsin, then this letter should help you understand Wisconsin's requirements.

Your boat must be registered in WISCONSIN:

- 1) If you have a boat with any kind of motor (GAS OR ELECTRIC)
- 2) If you have a sailboat that is over 12 feet long
- 3) Canoes DO NOT need to be registered unless motorized
- 4) If you use your boat primarily in Wisconsin
- 5) If you have the boat in Wisconsin for 60 days

We will be monitoring boats which are not registered in Wisconsin on various waters in Sawyer County for compliance with the boat registration requirement. If you are required to register your boat in Wisconsin you should do so now with the on-line registration program, by mail or at a Wisconsin DNR Service Center.
