

RLPOA DONATES \$1,500.0 TO LCO FISH STOCKING

On October 11, 2007 RLPOA (Round Lake Property Owners Association) donates \$1,500.0 to the LCO Conservation Department Fish Stocking Program.

On October 11, 2007 approximately 1288# “extended” walleye were stocked into Round Lake at the Timber Trail Resort Landing. These walleye fish were up to 7” long.



The LCO has an agreement with the Red Cliff Tribe who supplied the truck to deliver the walleye to Round Lake.



These fish today came from the [Aquaculture Demonstration Facility](#) located by the Red Cliff Indian Reservation and managed by UW Stevens Point. The walleye “fry” that the

Aquaculture Demonstration Facility grew to “extended” walleye came from the LCO Fish Hatchery on the SW part of the Chippewa Flowage.

About 1612# additional walleye were stocked last month into Round Lake by the LCO Tribe. A total of about 2900# extended walleye were stocked into Round Lake in this cooperative effort.
