Dan Tyrolt of the LCO Conservation Department is quoted "as believing Round Lake is now normal." But Lac Courte Oreilles is 16 to 18 inches low. If you check the banks of the stream south of the Little Round Lake dam, the water is 18 inches below where it normally has been.

All the elevations, orders and cfs, staff gauges don't seem to add up, when the shoreline I normally had is now six feet away from where it normally was!

To suggest we remove the dam and culverts on Highway NN for fear a big

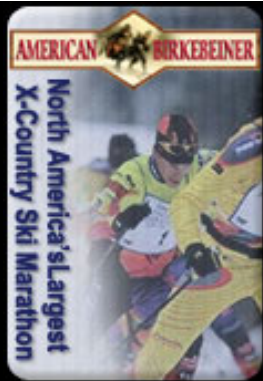


