1. Review Timelines
 - a. Proposed timelines distributed and reviewed. Proposal #1 compiled by County staff with completion in November. Proposal #2 is similar with the addition of a boat tour and completion in December. Discussion regarding the group's recommendation to the DNR for water levels, tribal jurisdiction, public participation and potential technical/engineering needs that may affect timeline.

2. Review History
 - a. Draft version of Management Plan History reviewed.
 - b. Language will be provided by Kafura to clarify the description of the watercourse east of Carlson Rd. Tribe will provide language to clarify ancestral history and other pertinent information.
 - c. All changes for final draft must be submitted to Eck by **March 17**.

3. Define Sub-groups, Work Objectives and Products
 - a. Sub-group objectives will be to evaluate and acquire available data related to appointed topic and then recommend possible action. DNR will guide/advise on legal processes for options.
