

Juveniles arrested in Round Lake burglaries

Sawyer County Sheriff's Department officers have arrested three male juveniles in connection with break-ins or attempted break-ins which occurred at six residences and 15 outbuildings near Round Lake in the vicinity of Highway B, Haskins Road and South Shore Road on the night of April 17-18.

A truck also was damaged, said Chief Deputy Tim Zeigle. A fire which destroyed a five-stall garage, fireworks and large boat owned by Grand Pines Resort and David W. (Famous Dave) Anderson in the same area early April 18 is still under investigation by the state fire marshall, Zeigle added.

Zeigle said that alarms were activated at several residences, which apparently scared the perpetrators off. One juvenile was arrested while the incidents were taking place and another juvenile was arrested later that day, he said.

Alcohol was stolen from one residence and a small amount of cash was taken from another residence, he added. "Other than that, not much was stolen."

The three juveniles who were arrested were referred to the Human Services Department juvenile court intake for charges, Zeigle added. Two of the males are 15 years old and one is 16.
