
Fire destroys large garage at Round Lake

A fire which may have been set by an arsonist destroyed a five-stall garage-storage building and a large boat at the David W. "Famous Dave" Anderson residence on the southwest side of Round Lake early Tuesday.

The fire was called in by a sheriff's deputy around 4:30 a.m. at the freestanding garage on the north side of Highway B about one-half mile west of the Round Lake Narrows. The Town of Hayward Fire Department

responded along with the Hayward Department of Natural Resources, as the fire was spreading into pine needles and brush beneath large red pines. Fireworks were reportedly stored in the building.

A suspect or suspects were being sought by officers on Tuesday, as a number of residential break-ins occurred in the vicinity around the same time. The Snowshoe Saloon also was broken into.

The incidents remain under investigation.
