Two men are charged with burglary of Round Lake fire station, maintenance shop

Sawyer County authorities have charged two local men with burglary and theft of more than \$11,000 worth of equipment from the Town of Round Lake Fire Department Station Two and Town Maintenance Building at 10625N Highway A between Sept. 26 and Oct. 2.

Kyle A. Dunster, 31, 12296N Upper A Road, Hayward, and Norman (Greg) Miller, 38, 15470 Salter Drive-Lot 32, Hayward, are charged with being party to burglary and felony theft at the shops.

Dunster also is charged with party to burglary and theft by returning to the Round Lake buildings a second time and stealing more property.

The court complaints filed by the district attorney state that on Oct. 16, the Sawyer County Sheriff's Department received a tip that equipment stolen from the Town of Round Lake was stored in a residential garage on Hay Lake Road in Washburn County. A stolen jack was recovered there. Washburn County and Sawyer County officers then executed a search warrant at another residence and recovered the majority of the stolen property there.

An informant stated that Dunster, Miller and another individual had brought the items to the Hay Lake Road address in Dunster's truck. The informant said Dunster and Miller had gone to the Round Lake Fire Department station with the intention of drilling a hole in a gas tank and stealing gas. Instead, they decided to break into the buildings.

Items which the perpetrators allegedly took from the buildings included a defibrillator off a fire engine, a Stihl K saw, a floating pump, a new generator from the rescue van, a positive pressure fan, a toolbox with a variety of tools, a light and reel, a floor jack, an older generator and a horizontal compressor.

Miller is summoned to appear in court at 11 a.m. Jan. 16, and Dunster is summoned to appear in court at 8:30 a.m. Jan. 28.
