Peninsula Road burglar sentenced

An area resident who was charged with seven residential burglaries on Peninsula Road near Round Lake in the summer of 2011 was sentenced last week in Sawyer County Circuit Court.

Dustin J. Butler, 18, 5097W Ellen Street, Winter, was convicted of two counts of party to burglary and one count party to theft of a gun at residences on Peninsula Road in the town of Hayward on Aug. 3, 2011. Dismissed and read in were five counts party to burglary, six counts party to theft and one count of criminal damage at residences on Peninsula Road.

A consecutive sentence of four years in prison plus four years of supervised release was imposed and stayed, and Butler was placed on five years of probation by Judge Gerald Wright. As conditions of probation, Butler and the two co-defendants must pay restitution totaling \$14,929, and have no contact with the victims. Butler must spend six months in the county jail with Huber privileges, pay a fine of \$924 plus \$1,399 in victim impact surcharges, maintain absolute sobriety, not use drugs without a valid prescription, not possess dangerous weapons, obtain and maintain employment, undergo counseling as deemed necessary by the Dept. of Corrections, provide a DNA sample and pay the \$250 surcharge.

Butler also was convicted of criminal damage to property by driving an ATV through cornfields along Peninsula Road and Round Lake School Road on Aug. 3, 2011. He was sentenced to nine months in jail with Huber privileges. He was assessed restitution of \$3,767 to two farmers. A charge of receiving stolen property

was dismissed and read in.

Butler also was convicted of party to burglary at a cabin on East River Drive in the town of Radisson on Dec. 24, 2011. He was placed on five years probation, and he and the co-defendants are liable for paying \$7,464 restitution. He is ordered to have no contact with the co-defendants or the victim.

Butler was convicted of battery to a 52-year-old male outside a residence on Gurno Lake Road on April 28 this year. He was sentenced to nine consecutive months in jail. Charges of felony bail jumping and disorderly conduct were dismissed and read in.
