

Plans continue for Little Round Lake dam replacement

Designs have been completed for the Little Round Lake dam replacement as work toward the project continues.

Dale Olson presented members of the Sawyer County Zoning and Conservation Committee last Wednesday with a draft of the construction drawings. The project will include removal of the existing road and bridge and construction of a box culvert with end sections and an end wall and reconstruction of the roadway, according to the construction document.



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Planning for staging of the project is under way. The plan is to replace the structure mid-week to have the least amount of impact on property owners on Carlson Road, Olson said.

Carlson Road is a private road and the properties along it are seasonal properties, he said.

A public hearing on the plan will be scheduled by the Wisconsin Department of Natural Resources and will likely be held in May with the work being done in August or September.

Affected property owners will be notified, he said.

In other business, supervisors approved surveying a property on the Tiger Cat Flowage that is expected to be included in the county land sale.
